**Financial support**: Students from partner institutions are eligible to receive a daily allowance supported by the Erasmus programme and granted by the sending institution.

**Accompanying staff**: Teaching staff from partner institutions can also participate in this project as an Erasmus lecturer/coach/guest speaker. Staff should receive funding from the sending university, which should cover mobility expenses, such as travel, accommodation, food.
