



"LEADERSHIP AND MANAGMENT IN HEALTH CARE: FROM NATIONAL TO GLOBAL PERSPECTIVES" 3 ECTS

About BIP

The COVID-19 pandemic, migration, war in Ukraine and other global health challenges has stressed the importance of effective leadership at all levels of the healthcare system and organizations. There is an urgent need to evaluate our previous experiences and prepare for future challenges. Therefore, Lithuanian University of Health Sciences has organized a Blended Intensive Programme (Blended learning activities are a combination of virtual/online learning activities and physical learning activities in the field of interest) dedicated to examining and learning about health management and leadership. During this course students will be acquainted with both basic concepts of leadership and up-to-date knowledge, skills, competencies, values, and attitudes, enabling them to take leadership roles in their communities.

Organization of the BIP

- The *BIP* will be organized in a blended learning format including an online session, group work and onsite sessions.
- Registration must be completed before 2PM, 14 December, 2022
- The Online session will be delivered in a MS Teams environment on December 15-16, 2022.
- The Onsite session will be organized and provided at the Lithuanian University of Health Sciences at January 9- 13, 2023.

For group work that will occur in the January session, students will form into two or three debate groups (each group has a 'For' and 'Against' team) – two teams of three debaters = 6 participants in a topic group. They will be asked to prepare for the following debate questions: (1) Leadership is the key to quality care in health; (2) Distributed leadership is the future strength of effective health care; (3) The impact of innovation in health care is not being achieved; (4) The expectations of consumers of healthcare cannot be achieved. A 10-point system will be used to evaluate the preparedness and participation in debates sessions. This group work will be a great opportunity to work with your colleagues from other countries, to share your experience and gain knowledge.
